



Tuition and Fees Schedule Grades JK-3

REGISTRATION FEE

The registration fee is a yearly fee paid when enrolling or re-enrolling your child. The fee is date sensitive to encourage early enrollment. (See table below.) There is a \$50 discount for **new** students who enroll within one week of acceptance. This fee is nonrefundable.

COMPREHENSIVE FEE

The comprehensive fee for elementary students (grades JK-5) is \$300 per year, which includes payment for elementary enrichment programs, technology, consumables, yearbook, student planner (3rd-8th), classroom parties and one royal-blue uniform shirt. This fee is nonrefundable.

EXTENDED DAY PROGRAM (EDP)

The extended day program is open to all students, and is available on contract or occasional basis. Contract EDP payments may be added to your tuition payments. Contract EDP covers regular scheduled school days only. There is no EDP during Christmas or Easter vacations, or national holidays. See the school calendar for half-days EDP may be available.

Families using EDP on an occasional basis only, need to purchase a pre-paid EDP card from the office. The minimum purchase is 10 hours at the cost of \$4.20 per hour (\$42.00).

PAYMENT OPTIONS

Tuition, comprehensive fee, and contract EDP fees are all due by the 1st of each month.

A.T.P.P. = Automated Tuition Payment Program automatically withdraws tuition payments and other fees from your bank account on a monthly basis.

NAP MATS

Junior Kindergarten and Kindergarten students require a nap mat, which are to be purchased for \$22 in the school office.

EMERGENCY KITS

All students must have an emergency kit to be kept in the classroom. Student Emergency Boxed Kits may be purchased in the school office for \$15. Kits have a shelf life of 5 years.

CLASSROOM SUPPLIES

Before the start of school, families will be given a list of classroom supplies to be purchased and brought to school on the first day.

LATE FEES

A \$25 late fee will be assessed when Tuition, EDP, or Comprehensive Fee payments are received after the 15th of the month.

PAST DUE ACCOUNTS

A student account that remains delinquent past the last day of the month may result in suspension of the student(s) and/or report cards being held until the balance is paid. Special circumstances will be considered by the Administration on an exceptional basis.

TUITION ASSISTANCE

Financial assistance is available for families who qualify. Applicants are encouraged to apply by 4/30/08.

OUTDOOR EDUCATION FEES

Outdoor Education fees cover room and board for the class trip taken in the spring (grades 4 through 8 only.) Fees vary by grade and are added to tuition payment. **Outdoor Education fees stated above do not include transportation.** Transportation fees will be determined and the fee due prior to the trip.

COMPREHENSIVE FEE

The comprehensive fee for elementary students (grades JK-5) is \$300 per year, which includes payment for elementary enrichment programs, technology, consumables, yearbook, student planner (3rd-8th), classroom parties and one royal-blue uniform shirt. This fee is nonrefundable.

The comprehensive fee for middle school students (grades 6-8) is \$400 per year, which includes payment for middle school enrichment programs, technology, consumables, classroom parties, yearbook, student planner, one royal-blue uniform shirt and specialty lab fees. This fee is nonrefundable.

EXTENDED DAY PROGRAM (EDP)

The extended day program is open to all students, and is available on contract or occasional basis. Contract EDP payments may be added to your tuition payments. Contract EDP covers regular scheduled school days only. There is no EDP during Christmas or Easter vacations, or national holidays. See the school calendar for half-days EDP may be available.

Families using EDP on an occasional basis only, need to purchase a pre-paid EDP card from the office. The minimum purchase is 10 hours at the cost of \$4.20 per hour (\$42.00).
